

These were actual questions asked by visitors to staffers and guides at American national parks:

**Mesa Verde National Park, Colorado:** "Did John Wayne or Clint Eastwood discover this park?"

**Everglades National Park, Florida:** "Are those alligators in the water there real, or like the mechanical ones at Disney World?"

**Denali National Park, Alaska:** Which president is Mount McKinley named after?" ...and... "Is it OK to feed and pet the grizzly bears from our car window?"
